Such requests should be made as early as possible as we cannot allocate adjoining blocks of tables after they have already been allocated to other exhibitors. Tables must be booked by table number and location. **“Same as last year” is not a table location.** We will accommodate these requests IF POSSIBLE. **Table layouts will be posted on our website.**

Kamloops Target Sports Association – Gun & Antique Show 2019 Rules and Information

The earlier your application is received, the better chance you have of your requirements being met. If you wish confirmation of your table space prior to the show dates, refer to the KTSA website. (www.ktsa.ca). We will update the website twice a month. If you have any questions contact the show registrar at kamloopsgunshow@ktsa.ca.

Make cheques payable to “KTSA Show” and mail to **P.O. Box 744 Kamloops, BC V2C 5M4**. **N.S.F. cheques will reduce the odds of your attendance at future shows.** You will receive your vendor package upon arrival at the Show.

Set-Up time: Friday, April 26th, 12 Noon to 9 pm. NO VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDINGS. We will have pallets and pallet movers available to assist you, but please bring your own dollies or carts if you have them. Only tables supplied by the “Show” will be used by vendors. Heavy load tables available on request. Vendors will not alter the floor plan or table layout without the approval of the “**Show Committee.**” Display items must not encroach on walkway areas. **The SHOW 2019** opens to the public on Saturday April 27th at 9 am to 5pm and Sunday April 28th, 9 am to 3 pm.

Exhibitors and their assistants MUST clearly display (wear) name tags and ribbons at all times.

The Exhibitor and/or an assistant must remain at the trade/display table for the entire duration of the Show, **which means Saturday 9 AM to 5 PM and Sunday 9 AM to 3 PM.** **Exhibitors who leave before 3 PM on Sunday without permission of the Committee will be removed from future shows.** All exhibitors from Vancouver Island are urged to “Reserve a berth” on the 9 o’clock ferry. **Do not depend on catching the 7 o’clock ferry.**

NO SETTING UP ON Saturday MORNING, **unless PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED.** In this case **SET UP must be completed before the show opens to the public at 9 AM.**

On SUNDAY at 3 pm, to avoid congestion, all exhibitors will pack their goods without blocking the walkway to allow the removal of other exhibitors’ goods that may be ready before yours are. You are asked to pack as expeditiously as possible as the entire building **MUST** be cleared no later than 6:00 PM. Vehicles will be allowed in the loading area only when packed goods are waiting to be loaded.

If for any reason (illness, accident, family or business matter) the Exhibitor must cancel his participation in this Show, he/she must notify the committee by phone, mail or Email as soon as possible. Refunds will be made if notice received before **Friday, April 12th 2019.**

NOTE: No transfer or sale of your table(s) to anyone. Tables will be re-assigned to people on the waiting list. **Emergency Contact Cell Phone Number (250) 319-1916. (Don Morphy - Show Chairman).**

All Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws must be observed. All restricted firearms must be trigger locked and secured to the table or in a locked case. Non restricted firearms must have bolt removed or a secure locking device installed and appropriately attached. Exhibitors and all persons acquiring firearms and/or ammunition must be in possession of a **valid PAL or POL** as required. Check their expiration dates.

Confirm that all firearms are unloaded when you arrive and after each has been displayed. Let no one handle a firearm in an unsafe manner. **No ammunition is to be loaded into a firearm for any reason whatsoever.** For safety sake take nothing for granted. Always keep them locked and secure. **Black powder is not permitted on the premises.** Smokeless powder must be in factory containers.

For your protection: **A written receipt or a KTSA Show and Sale sticker must accompany all purchases for security clearance.** No one will be allowed to remove articles from the building during the show without a sales receipt or proof of ownership. **All Firearm Sales must have a written receipt (provided by the vendor, KTSA does not provide them) showing the description, make, model and serial number (if available).**


The use of these facilities, including, but not limited to, loading and unloading your vehicle, is done at the risk of the Exhibitor, his partners, helpers or guests. The Show Committee, the Kamloops Target Sports Association, nor the City of Kamloops are liable to any Exhibitor, his partners, helpers or guests for any damage whatsoever, including but not limited to, damage to a vehicle or any part or attachment to it. The driver and/or owner of any vehicle and the Exhibitor are jointly and severally liable for any Personal Injury, damage to the building, contents of the building, exhibits or any other damage whatsoever.

No pets of any kind (dogs, cats, etc.) are allowed on McArthur Island. (City of Kamloops By-Law)

Remember to provide your own table covers capable of reaching the floor in front of your table, keeping material and products stored under the table out of sight. Bring additional tablecloths to cover everything before and after Show times. KTSA provides professional security on site 24/7 for the duration of the Show.

The Show Committee reserves the right in its sole discretion to accept or reject any application. The Show Committee also reserves the right to request removal of an exhibitor who is disrespectful in any way to anyone. No vendor shall set up a table that is deemed to be unsuitable for this show. Vendors that refuse to abide by **any** of these rules will be removed forthwith and denied future participation.

All vendors are urged to conduct themselves in a professional and safe manner at all times. Shows of this nature can serve as an educational tool to counteract the anti-gun rhetoric.
